



Frequently Asked Questions for the Spring Fling at Galot APRIL 27 - MAY 1, 2020

How do I sign up for the text event updates service for the Spring Fling Galot?

Simply text the word GALOT to the number 74121. Once signed up you will receive event updates, lane calls, and all pertinent event information.

What address will lead me to the correct gate/entrance?

If you are using google maps (or similar), the 4129 NC Hwy 242 South address will map you to the correct gate entrance. If you get there before Tuesday morning you will be directed in the holding lot.

When will the gates open for Spring Fling parking?

Gates will open Tuesday at 9am for Spring Fling event parking. Tuesday will also be a test and tune 2pm-9pm for \$50. The Mullis 32-car 20K shootout (shootout is full) will also take place on Tuesday. Any racers that are racing the event at Galot this weekend, will be asked to head to the holding lot until gates open Tuesday morning for the Spring Fling event.

Is this a Pre-entry event?

No. All Fling events for 2021 will be 'gate entry' events.

Can I buy a single day entry if I cannot make the full event?

Yes, Single day entries are \$300 for Thursday or Saturday and \$475 for Friday.

What is the Galot track radio station?

100.1 FM.

What are the general rules for the Spring Fling Galot?

One important rule to note is that 'A Vehicle can only go down the track once per round'. This rule is implemented at all Fling events (except for Vegas). TruSTART and Autostart will both be in effect. Please refer to the Racer Information Sheet (handed to you at front gate) for all Spring Fling rules and guidelines.

Will any tire companies be at the event?

Yes, Hoosier and Goodyear will be attending and stocked with the most popular tires.

What fuel will be sold at the event?

David from VP will be at the event selling VP fuels and taking pre-orders as well. Contact Dave at 910-624-2543 to pre-order.

How will the Electric Hookup spots be handled?

The electric hookup spots will be first come first serve as racers pull in the gate. We will have our 4-person parking staff to guide you and answer any questions. Electric Hookups will be \$150 for the week with money collected after you are parked.

Can I save my friend a parking spot next to me?

We MAY allow you to save 1 parking spot next to you for a friend IF your friend is on the way to the event (no spots held for an extended period of time). Please do not ask for more than that as it will be strictly enforced. If there is a large crowd at the event, we will not allow the saving any spots in the electric hookup parking areas. Our parking staff will be there to help you and maximize space. Please be respectful and work with them as they are there to help.

What food/concessions will be sold at the event?

The Galot trackside café will be open for business selling the traditional American foods. The popular 'Giddy Piggy' will be on site. Also, we will have a free donut/coffee station set up on select mornings. Friday night; our Mullis Racer Appreciation Dinner is open to all drivers and crew at no charge.

Will a RV 'pump truck' be servicing the event?

Yes, the pump truck will be making their way through the pits twice during the event.

If I have an issue while at the event, who should I contact?

We will have a full staff of both Fling and Galot employees on hand to help. We will also have our Fling Help Desk set up at the bottom of the tower.
